CONTRACT COVERING NON PASSAGE OF TRAFFIC REGULATIONS OBSTRUCTING THROUGH TRAFFIC

This agreement made by and between the State Highway Department of the State of Mississippi, hereinafter called the "Department", and the Walnut Grove of Walnut Grove, Mississippi, hereinafter called the "town" witnesseth:

WHEREAS, The Department with the aid of the Public Roads Administration desires to construct a section of Mississippi Highway Route No. 16 from a point designated as the beginning of Project to the north corporate limit known as 1st 1st (S) Lake County

and,

WHEREAS, The Administration has made certain rules and regulations requiring that the town or Department will not permit any encroachments upon their right-of-way of said Highway within the corporate limits, that the town or Department will not pass any laws, rules, regulations or ordinances, which will penalize, hinder or obstruct the free movement of traffic on the said road over and along which said construction work is to be done, by setting unreasonable speed limits, erecting or maintaining so-called semaphore, or red and green "Stop and Go" lights, or in any manner making traffic on the said road secondary and favoring traffic on abutting or cross streets.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the construction of said section of Miss. Highway No. 16 by the said Department, with the aid and assistance of the Administration, the town of Walnut Grove agrees, obligates and binds itself to prevent any encroachments upon the right-of-way limits of said Highway, and furthermore agrees, obligates and binds itself that it will not pass any laws, rules, regulations or ordinances which would be in conflict with the above prescribed conditions of the Administration.

It is further agreed that the contents of this Agreement be entered upon the official minutes of the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of Walnut Grove, Mississippi, and a copy of this contract be filed with the State Highway Department of the State of Mississippi and a copy filed with the Public Roads Administration, U. S. Department of Agriculture.



The following Ordinance was passed Section by Section and then as a whole. Ordinance 105. an Ordinance providing who shall work on the public Streets of the town of Walnutgrove, Leake County Mississippi and providing for the Commutation Tax thereof, Be it ordained by the Mayor and Board of Alderman of the town of Walnut grove, Leake County Mississippi, Tuesday the 1st day of October 1946.

That

Sec. 1 All male persons over the age of 21 years and under the age of 50 years, not Blind nor deaf nor dumb nor otherwise disabled by disease, or loss of limb and not an ordained minister of the gospel, in Charge of Churches, Rabies and priest, shall be liable to work on the public streets in the town of Walnutgrove, During the taxable year beginning on the 1st day of July 1946 and ending June 30 1947 no person shall be required to work ~~more~~ on public streets of said town more than five days, during the said year, and 8 hours constant, diligent labor shall constitute a days work upon the public streets of said town and suitable deduction will be made for the time short of this number of hours either from negligence or idleness.

Sec. 2 Every such person may commute the labor for which he is liable to perfor on public streets of said town, by paying the tax collector

of said town on or before the 16 day of December 1946 the sum of \$3.00 before default.

Sec. 3 That the Marshal of the said town shall enumerate the number of names of each and all persons liable to work on the streets in said town and furnish the street commissioner of the names

Sec. 4 any person liable to work on the streets of said town failing to perform the labor herein required or to pay the sum of \$3.00 herein required or commute the same upon conviction shall be fined the sum of six dollars and all cost.

Sec. 5 for cause that this Ordinance be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage of this date.
