Be it Ordained by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Walnut Grove, Mississippi, Tuesday the 5th, day of September, 1950.

THAT

Sec, 1. All male persons over the age of twenty one years and under the age of fifty years, not blind, nor deaf nor dumb nor otherwise disabled by disease, or loss of limb and not an ordained minister of the Gospel, in charge of Churches, Rabbis and Priests, shall be liable to work on the public streets in said town of Walnut Grove, during the taxable year, beginning on the first day of July, 1950 and ending June 30th, 1951. No person shall be required to work on public streets of said town more than five days during the said year, and eight hours constant, diligent labor shall constitute a days work upon the streets of said town and suitable deductions shall be made for the time short of the number of hours either from negligence or idleness.

Sec, 2 Every such person may commute the labor for which he is liable to perform on the streets of said town by paying the tax collector of said town on or before the 16th, day of December 1950 the sum of \$5.00 before default.

Sec, 3 That the marshall of said town shall enumerate the names of each and all persons liable to work on the streets in said town and furnish same to the street commissioner.

Sec, 4 Any person liable to work on the streets of said town, failing to perform the labor herein required or to pay the sum of \$5.00 herein required or commute the same, upon conviction shall be fined the sum of \$10.00 and all cost.

Sec, 5 For cause that this ordinance be in full force and effect immediately and after the passage on this date.

An Ordinance, entitled, An Ordinance providing that all crimes committed within the corporate limits of the town of Walnut Grove, Leake County, Mississippi, amounting to a Misdemeanor under the Penal Laws of the State of Mississippi, shall when committed within the corporate limits of said town of Walnut Grove, be deemed an offence against said town.

Sec. 1. Be it ordained by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the town of Walnut Grove, Leake County, Mississippi that all offences amounting to a misdemeanor under the penal laws of the state of Mississippi shall when committed within the corporate limits of said town of Walnut Grove, be deemed an offence against said town.

Sec. 2 Be it further ordained that any person found guilty of committing any such offences within the corporate limits of said town shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and sentenced to pay a fine not exceeding \$100.00 or to serve not exceeding 30 days in jail or both fine and imprisonment.

Sec. 3. Be it further ordained that all Ordinances and part of Ordinances in conflict with the term of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

Sec. 4. Be it further Ordained that this Ordinance shall be in force and take effect as provided by law.
