LEASE and AGREEMENT

This lease and agreement entered into by and between the town of Walnut Grove, Mississippi a municipal sub-division of the state of Mississippi, hereinafter called the "town", and the Hinds Paving Company, of Jackson, Mississippi hereinafter called the "company", as follows:

The said town desiring to improve its streets therein which said streets have been designated in plans and specifications adopted by the board of mayor and aldermen of said town by double surfacing, slag and bituminous treatment; and it appearing that the town does not own the necessary equipment nor the trained operators to operate same; and the said town having through its proper authorities contacted the Hinds Paving Company of Jackson, Mississippi, which owns and operates the necessary equipment for completing such work.

The Hinds Paving Company having inspected the streets sought to be so improved and having indicated that it would rent or lease its equipment necessary for completing said work to said town at and for the sum of \$1.20 per square yard. The said town to furnish all material for said work.

The said town by and through its proper mayor and board of alderman having agreed to lease or rent the said equipment and operators from the said Hinds Paving Company and to pay said Hinds Paving Company the sum of \$1.20 per square yard for the use of said equipment and operators; the said mayor and board of aldermen having set forth its agreement in the minutes of said mayor and board of alderman in open meeting properly held; and the said town having authorized its mayor to enter into formal lease or rental agreement with the said company as aforesaid, and the said company having agreed to said agreement.

Now therefore be it known that the town of Walnut Grove, Mississippi, acting by and through its said mayor does hereby rent or lease from the Hinds Paving Company of Jackson, Mississippi, all

necessary machinery and equipment that is required to prepare the streets for treating and for the spreading thereon all necessary material for double surface slag and bituminous treatment and said town agrees to pay the said company for the use of said machinery and operators thereof the sum of \$1.20 per square yard of such material spread and streets completed according to plans and specification that both town and company are familiar with. That at the completion of the job all work shall be measured and paid for at the rate of \$1.20 per square yard.

The said town to furnish all materials for said work.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING WHO SHALL WORK ON THE PUBLIC STREETS OF THE TOWN ON WALNUT GROVE, LEAKE COUNTY MISSISSIPPI AND PROVIDING FOR THE COMMUTATION TAX THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the town of Walnut Grove, Mississippi Tuesday the ~~17th~~ day of October, 1951.

THAT

Sec. 1. All male persons over the age of 21 years and under the age of 50 years, not blind, nor deaf nor dumb nor otherwise disabled by disease, or loss of limb and not an ordained minister of the Gospel, in charge of Churches, Rabies, and Priest, shall be liable to work on the Public Streets in the said town of Walnut Grove, during the taxable year, beginning on the first day of July, 1951 and ending June 30th, 1952, no person shall be required to work on public streets of said town more than 5 days during the said year, and 8 hours constant, diligent labor shall constitute a days work upon the streets of said town and suitable deduction shall be made for the time short of the number of hours either from negligence or idleness. Sec. 2, Every such person may commute the labor for which he is liable to perform on the streets of said town by paying the tax collector of said town of or before the 16th day of Dec. 1951, the sum of \$5.00 before default. Sec. 3, That the Marshal of said town shall enumerate the number of names of each and all persons liable to work on the streets in said town and furnish the street commissioner. Sec. 4, Any person liable to work on the streets of said town failing to perform the labor herein required or to pay the sum of \$5.00 herein required or commute the same upon conviction shall be fined the sum of \$10.00 and all cost. Sec. 5, For cause that this ordinance be in full force and effect immediately and after the passage of this date.
