Sec. 4. Be it further ordained that this ordinance shall be in force and take effect as provided by law.

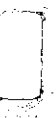


