ORDER AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE TOWN TAX COLLECTOR TO DEPOSIT FUNDS RECEIVED FROM COLLECTION OF AUTOMOBILE AD VALOREM TAXES IN CERTAIN FUNDS, TO TRANSFER CERTAIN FUNDS HERETOFORE RECEIVED TO PROPER FUNDS, ETC.

There came on for consideration by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen the matter of the collection of the automobile advalorem taxes, and the depositing of said funds collected in the proper fund, and it appearing that the levy for General Town Fund is 15 mills and the levy for Street Fund is 5 mills, and that 75% of said taxes as collected should be in the General Town Fund and it appearing that the Town Tax Collector has deposited all of said automobile ad valorem taxes collected for the period October, 1959, through February, 1960, in the General Town Fund; and $\frac{1}{4}$ of said sum should have been deposited in the Street Tax Fund, and on further consideration of said matter:

On motion duly made and seconded, it is ordered that the Town Tax Collector and Town Clerk, Mrs. Essie F. Harrelson be and she is authorized, ordered and directed to transfer from the General Town Fund to the Street Tax Fund an amount equal to $\frac{5}{20}$ or 25% of all funds received by her on account of automobile advalorem tax collections for the period October, 1959, through February, 1960, and that she be further directed to deposit $\frac{5}{20}$ of all such funds received by her from said source into the Street Tax Fund until further order of this Board, or until the levies of taxes for various funds shall have been changed by proper order of this Board.


