#### NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Sealed bids will be received by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Walnut Grove, Mississippi, until the hour of 2:00 P.M. on Tuesday the 17th day of September, A.D., 1963, and shortly thereafter publicly opened for construction of approximately 33,234 square yards of one coat of slag and one coat of asphalt seal, in accord with specifications meeting Mississippi Highway Department specifications for such type work.


