MISSISSIPPI, HELD ON DECEMBER 1, 1981

BE IT REMEMBERED and it is hereby certified to that the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Walnut Grove, Mississippi, met in regular session on Tuesday, December 1, 1981 at the City Hall at 6:00 P.M., this being the time and place for said meeting. The following business was transacted to-wit!

On motion by Alderman Glynn Edwards, seconded by Alderman R. M. Allen and affirmative vote of all aldermen, the Board appointed C. R. Murphy as Election Commissioner for the Town of Walnut Grove, since the death of W. C. Dawson created a vacancy for this position.

On motion by Alderman Spence, seconded by Alderman Madden, the Board voted to pay the registration fee of \$15.00 each for the Mayor and Clerk to attend a seminar at Jackson.

The Reverend Mr. George Roberts requested permission to meet with the Mayor and Board of Aldermen during this regular December 1981 meeting. At the meeting Mr. Roberts stated to the Board his intention of making certain improvements on the real property which he owns within the municipality, and requested that the Board consider furnishing 3 street lights at proposed unimproved driveways.

Following a period of questioning and answering and after considerable discussion, the following motion was made, seconded and carried to-wit:

The Board, having considered the improvements presently existing on property and in addition, the matter of the economic profitability to the Town, that at the present time, it is not in the best interest of the municipality to furnish the aforementioned street lights.

On motion by Alderman W. C. Spence, seconded by Alderman J. W. Madden the following memorial resolution was adopted:

BE IT REMEMBERED, that the following Memorial Resolution was unanimously adopted by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Walnut Grove at its regular meeting on December 1, 1981, as follows:

WHEREAS, W. C. (Bob) Dawson departed this life on the 6th day of September, 1981, and

WHEREAS,, Bob Dawson distinguished himself in public life, serving as Mayor of the Town of Walnut Grove from 1957-1961, and then again from 1977-1981, and

WHEREAS, this body politic recognizes and takes note of the progress and achievements of the Town of Walnut Grove during the periods of leadership of Bob Dawson; that in taking the measure of this man he was found not wanting or lacking in those areas of life which are of most importance and enduring, to-wit: "a good husband", "a good father", "an honest, diligent and progressive public official", and, most of all, "a servant of God".

NOW THEREFORE, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen unanimously adopt this Memorial Resolution, ordering that it not only be spread upon its permanent minutes but published in The Carthaginian and a copy furnished to the family of Bob Dawson. Farewell to our good and faithful friend and may God bless the family of Bob Dawson.


