Natural Gas Line Relocation Agreement  
State Aid Project No. SAP-62(38)  
Old Highway 35-Tuscola Road  
Scott County, Mississippi

Whereas, the Scott County Board of Supervisors proposes to improve and construct a county highway along a local road known as the Old Highway 35-Tuscola Road, said construction to be accomplished under State Aid Project No. SAP-62(38), and,

Whereas, a natural gas line is present within and parallel to the existing gravel roadway, and,

Whereas, the said natural gas line will fall within the project construction limits and will conflict with the proposed construction in certain locations, and,

Whereas, the southern portion of the gas line (Sta. 0+00 to Sta. 62+50) is located on private easements and the northern portion of the gas line (Sta. 62+50 to Sta. 84+50) is located on public right-of-way (within the maintained area of the existing gravel road),

Now, therefore, it is hereby agreed between the Scott County Board of Supervisors and the Town of Walnut Grove, Mississippi, that the gas line shall be relocated outside the construction limits of the proposed project in the following locations:

Between Sta. 20+00 and Sta. 22+50  
Between Sta. 34+00 and Sta. 37+50  
Between Sta. 50+50 and Sta. 54+50  
Between Sta. 66+50 and Sta. 70+50  
Between Sta. 77+50 and Sta. 81+00

It is further agreed that all service lines and meters presently located within the construction limits of the project shall be re-located outside the said construction limits.

It is further agreed that the cost of relocating the gas main shall be paid by District 1 of Scott County, said cost to be determined by competitive bids secured by the Town of Walnut Grove, and that the cost of relocating all service lines and meters shall be paid by the Town of Walnut Grove, Mississippi.

It is further agreed that after completion of the project, no disturbance of the roadway shall be made in the future. If problems occur of a nature requiring repairs within the crown of the roadway, the gas line shall be abandoned and replaced with a line outside the right-of-way of the road. All costs for such relocation shall be paid by the Town of Walnut Grove, Mississippi, or the Owner of the gas line, if different.

The Board met in this recessed session to take another look at the income and expenses of the gas system and to try to determine if possibly the Town could reduce its rates to gas customers.


After discussion of the amount of expenses that have been reduced and talking with an official from United Gas Pipe Line, who informed the Town that no further rate increase is planned for the next several months, the Board voted for the Walnut Grove Gas System to return to the rates set for November, 1, 1982, which shall be effective on the April 1, 1983 bills, which is as follows:

For the First 500 cu. ft	11.00 (Min. bill)
For the next 4,500 cu. ft.	8.00 Per MCF
For the next 45,000 cu. ft.	6.50 Per MCF
For all over 50,000 cu. ft.	6.00 per MCF


The above motion being made by Alderman Glynn Edwards, seconded by Alderman J. W. Madden, with affirmative voted of all aldermen present, it was carried.
