



The following business was transacted to-wit:



Brackin, seconded by Alderman Glynn Edwards and affirmative vote of all aldermen present, the Board authorized the Mayor to enter into a contract with Dr. Wesley Parkhurst, Jr, M.D. for medical services at the Walnut Grove Medical Clinic and to do any and all things necessary and lawful for the opening of such clinic at the earliest possible date.

The matter of a tax exemption for Swedenburg Lumber Company was discussed, and it was requested that the necessary paper work be done to give them a ten year tax exemption.


