The following business was transacted to-wit, after prayer by Aldermen, Rev. Leon Young.

Brian Gomillion, Aldermen, made the motion to prohibit smoking in the following buildings owned by the Town of Walnut Grove, City Hall, Old City Hall, Library, Medical Clinic Building and Fire Station, this motion was seconded by Aldermen Don Gomillion and an "AYE" vote by all the Board of Aldermen.

The Clerk requested a transfer from Gas System Revenue of \$15,000.00 into General Town Funds, this request was granted on motion by Aldermen Brian Gomillion, seconded by Aldermen Don Gomillion and unanimous approval by all the Board of Aldermen.

Bob Wells and associates from the University of Southern
Mississippi Center for Community and Economic Development
proposed to the Mayor and Board of Aldermen in exchange for
transportation costs of staff and students, to develop a
comprehensive land use, zoning and capital improvement plan
for the Town of Walnut Grove. Brian Gomillion, Aldermen, made
the Motion with Marcus Ellis, Jr., Aldermen seconded and an
"AYE" vote from all the Board of Aldermen.

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen unanimously agreed to go into partnership with Tennesse Valley Authority, Central Electric Power Association, and Leake County Industrial Development Association, on a sign for the Walnut Grove - Leake County industrial parks on Highway 35 in Walnut Grove on motion by Aldermen Brian Gomillion and seconded by Aldermen Marcus Ellis. The sign will be a permanent brick sign size 6 foot by 20 foot and the amount to be contributed is \$1,000.00 and do site preparation by the maintance crew.

Attorney Jeff Webb asked for authority to get clear title to the railroad property the Town wants from Monticello Hardwood, as the railroad just gave Monticello Hardwood a quick-claim deed for the property, this was approved on motion by Aldermen Marcus Ellis, seconded by Aldermen Don Gomillion, and an "AYE" vote by all the Board of Aldermen.

N. L. Carson, Ray Britt, and Linda Shepard from the Leake County Industrial and Economic Development Board to request up to \$5,000.00 for operating costs for the year 2001 and to make it a yearly budget item, this was approved on motion by Aldermen Brian Gomillion, seconded by Aldermen Marcus Ellis and an "AYE" vote by all the Board of Aldermen.

Jennifer Buford of East Central Planning and Development made known to the Town officials of a police grant for unbudgeted items for up to \$8,000.00 with 10% matching funds. It was approved to apply for this grant on motion made by Aldermen Brian Gomillion, seconded by Aldermen Marcus Ellis and an "AYE" vote by all the Board of Aldermen.

Mildred Tucker came to the meeting to request natural gas services be extended down Old Jackson Road in Scott County to her home and some neighbors. No action was taken on this matter at this time the Mayor and Maintance Supervisor are to look at extending the gas line costs and how many customers it would add and report back to the Board of Aldermen.

Jimmie Lewis Deputy#3 resigned and his resignation was accepted on motion by Aldermen Marcus Ellis, seconded by Aldermen W. C. 'Croft, and an "AYE" vote by all the Board of Aldermen.

Only two applications were received for the Deputy #3 position Dustan Sanders and Mac Arthur Williamson, since no applicant is certified, it was decided to advertise the deputy position in the Carthaginian, Scott County Times, and the Clarion Ledger for three weeks on motion by Aldermen Don Gomillion, seconded by Aldermen Marcus Ellis and an "AYE"vote by all the Board of Aldermen.
